DESCRIPTIONS OF ADVENTURES

All games are sophisticated 3-part adventures with masses of text, RAM save and UNDO (not 48K Spectrum and 64K CPC tape), good parsers, and graphics on many versions: Orc and Gnome pics are digitised; Jewels and Dreams pictures are cartoon-style. Each game is beautifully packaged with an accompanying book.

Jewels of Darkness (pub: Rainbird, program by Level 9)
The ultimate, mega-mix version of Level 9's acclaimed Colossal, Quest and Dungeon Adventures. You control the destiny of Middle Earth in the Age of the Demon Lord, using your skills of logical thought and mental dexterity to solve intricate problems and deftly contrived puzzles.

Silicon Dreams (pub: Rainbird, program by Level 9)
Level 9's challenging SF trilogy: Snowball, Return to Eden and Worm in Paradise. Can you save the colony starship Snowball 9, tackle the deadly paradise of Eden's jungles and 'beat the system' in the robot city of Enoch?

Knight Orc (pub: Rainbird, program by Level 9)
A game which turns the tables on hack-and-slay adventures. The orcs are revolting and you play Grindleguts, whose mission is to team up with other persecuted monsters and defeat the humans for a change.

* All but two versions of Time and Magik are now finished, and will be on sale early in May.

The two exceptions are the "new" versions, for Spectrum +3 and BBC, which will be available about a month later. (The BBC version marks Level 9's return to the Beeb. It will run on the Master, and BBCs with common types of memory expansion, but precise hardware needs will not be known until programming is complete.)

Gnome Ranger will be available for the +3 and BBC on the same date.

* By popular request from 520ST owners, Time and Magik allows you to choose between four sizes of text on the ST. And it includes instructions for copying the new adventure interpreter for use with your existing copy of Knight Orc or Gnome Ranger - giving them big text as well.

* The next Level 9 game from Mandarin is "Lancelot", a faithful retelling of the tales of King Arthur. Coding is almost finished, and Lancelot will be available early this Summer.
